








SB4: New Characters

- Katsuie Shibata
 - Low-rank vanguard under the Oda force. In the past he tried to rebel but failed. Is despaired in everything to the point that he's even losing emotions
- Sakon Shima
 - Vassal of Ishida Mitsunari, Sakon is a cheerful young man who enjoys gambling and his flirtatious look
- Yamanaka Shikanosuke
 - A young man who serves Amago Haruhisa, whom went missing, so he sets out on a journey to find him with the assistance of his deer companion,
 Oyassan (sometimes referred to as Pops)

• Naotora Ii

- Hot-blooded female general of the Ii army burns
 with animosity towards all of the world's men
- Swings her sword for the sake of making a world for maidens, offering relief to the maidens who grieve in war
- In the past, her fiance fled due to the war with the Takeda army dragging on for so long
 - It's because of this that she harbors one-sided hostility towards Takeda




- Matabei Gatou
 - A former Kuroda general, now ronin, who wanders around Japan. He has a high pride and despises people who hurt his pride, one of them being Masamune
- (secret) Maria Kyōgoku
 - Azai's older sister. She thinks herself is the only one in this world that has a value, and when looking at other people, she wonders if they are suitable for her
- Ashikaga Yoshiteru
 - The 13th Ashikaga shogun who longs for heated battles. He relinquishes the shogun rule back to the Emperor, which in turn causes the Sengoku Genesis




















Yukimura Genjiro Sanada

DA TE MA SA MUNE

- At the age of 14 in 1581 Masamune led his first campaign, helping his father fight the Sōma family
- Smallpox ruined the sight of his right eye but it isn't exactly sure what ruined the entire organ
- Because of his missing eye, his own mother condemned him as unfit to take over as clan leader and began favoring his younger brother as heir.

Yukimura Genjiro Sanada

- Never referred to as "Yukimura", name surfaced in a military novel written during the Edo period
- Generally, Yukimura as portrayed in the anime is more like Sanada Masayuki (his father), since he was actually Takeda's retainer



KOJURO KATAKURA

- Title of the present retainer of the current Date clan head
 - During this time period, is Katakura Kagetsuna that's the present retainer
- 1st served the Date clan as a junior page under Date's father, Terumune
- Recommended to Date that he surrender to Hideyoshi during the Odawara campaign

Sasuke Sarutobi

• Fictitious ninja that was a part of & the leader of the Sanada 10 Braves that served Yukimura Sanada & assisted him during the battles of Osaka Castle

Takeda Shingen

• Kenshin Uesugi




TA KEDA SHINGEN

- When he celebrated his coming of age (Seijin no Hi), given the formal name of "Harunobu" (which included a character from the name of Ashikaga Yoshiharu)
- A descendent from the Minamoto (genji) clan
 - & is referred to as "Minamoto-no-Harunobu" in official records kept by the Imperial Court
- He had been an accomplished poet in his youth

Kenshin Uesugi

- Original name "Nagao Kagetora"
- His rule led to a rise in standard of living in Echigo
- Believed in the Buddhist God of War, Bishamonten



FUMA KOTARO

- Name adopted by the leader of the ninja Fuma clan
 - According to some records, name was originally 'Kazama'
- Clan specialized in horseback guerilla warfare
- A popular story says that in 1596, Kotarō was responsible for the death of Hattori Hanzō, a famous ninja in the service of Tokugawa Ieyasu

MO URI MO TO NA RI

- Sandwiched between the powerful Amago and Ouchi clans, Motonari led the clan by carefully balancing actions and diplomacy
- Motonari succeeded in defeating both and controlled the entire Chūgoku area
- He had three sons, Mōri Takamoto, Kikkawa Motoharu, and Kobayakawa Takakage, whom he encouraged to work together for the benefit of the Mōri clan

Motochika Chosokabe

- 21st chief of the Chōsokabe clan of Tosa Province (presentday Kōchi Prefecture)
- Was the son and heir of Chōsokabe
 Kunichika and his mother was a daughter of the Saitō clan of Mino Province


Oichi Nagamasa Azai

NA GAMASA A ZA I

- Remembered as being a capable commander of troops on the battlefield
- Sudden war between two Asai clan allies (Asakura & Oda) is reported to have divided the clan
 - Many retainers wished to honor alliance with the Asakura while Azai remained neutral (essentially siding with Nobunaga)
 - Eventually, stayed allied w/ Asakura
- Eventually, Azai chose to commit seppuku shortly after the Asakura was destroyed

Oichi

- Wife of Nagamasa
- Bore 1 son & 3
 daughters: Manjumaru,
 Yodo-dono, Ohatsu, &
 Oeyo
- Was actually torn
 between loyalty to her
 husband & her brother



RANMARU MORI

- Originally "Mori Naritoshi"
- Had 5 brothers in total & member of the Mori clan
- From an early age, was an attendant of Oda Nobunaga
- Perished at the Incident at Honnō-ji defending Oda Nobunaga

Nouhime

- "Lady Nou", also Kicho
 - Since she came from the Mino Province, commonly reffered to as Nouhime
- Wife of Oda
- She was skilled in both the sword and a selection of martial arts
- Possibly sent to assassinate Oda Nobunaga
 - Spy for her maiden family
- Not sure what happened to her post the Incident at Honnō-ji



HIDEYO SHI TO YO TO MI

- Hideyoshi played an important role in the history of Christianity in Japan when he ordered the execution by crucifixion of twenty-six Christians
- Toyotomi Hideyoshi had been given the nickname Kozaru, meaning "little monkey", from his lord Oda Nobunaga because his facial features and skinny form resembled that of a monkey
 - Also known as the "bald rat."
- Some of his cultural legacy: imposition of a rigid class structure, restriction on travel, and surveys of land and production

Takenaka Hanbei

- Originally "Takenaka Shigeharu"
- Shigeharu made many contributions to Hideyoshi with his exceptional talent in that field
- He died of illness during Hideyoshi's attack against the Mōri in the Chūgoku region of Japan, while Miki Castle was being besieged



TO SHIE MA EDA

- 4th of 7 brothers
- Childhood name was "Inuchiyo"
- Was known as the "Yari no Mataza";
 Matazaemon being his common name
 - Highest rank from the court that he received is the Great
 Counselor Dainagon

Matsu

- Aka "Omatsu no Kata"
- Founded the Kaga Domain
- Skilled at both literary and martial arts
- Had 6 kids; 2 sons & 4 daughters

Shimazu Yoshihiro

Musashi Miyamoto



SHIMA ZU YO SHIHIRO

- Skilled general
- contributed greatly to the unification of Kyūshū
- For the Battle of Sekigahara on 1600, Yoshihiro was supposed to take the side of Tokugawa Ieyasu
 - But he was crushed by Torii Mototada on arriving for a rescue at Fushimi Castle
 - After being humiliated, took the side of Ishida Mitsunari instead.


Musashi Miyamoto

- Super famous samurai
- Childhood name of Bennosuke
- Early life details are difficult to confirm
- Defeated the other famous samurai, Sasaki Kojiro
 - With an oar carved to a bokken/bokuto(?)

• Maeda Keiji



• Saika Magoichi



MA EDA KELJII

- Born "Maeda Toshimasu", aka "Keijiro"
- Vagabond samurai
- Originally born to Takigawa Kazumasa but adopted by Maeda Toshihisa (older bro of Toshiie)
- Was supposed to be leader of the Maeda clan, but Toshiie was placed as head instead by Oda Nobunaga
- Also, well known for not getting along w/ Toshiie
 - Maybe b/c of not being family head

Saika Magoichi

- Historically was male
- Also, known as the female version of Kim Chung-seon, who was born Sayaga
- Group was reputed for their expert rifle formations and tactics
 - Reported to have posed a threat to Nobunaga on more than one occasion

ODA NOBUNAGA

- Originally unified Japan
 - Granted, didn't get to really bask in his glory for all that long
- May have made lacquered skull cups of his nephews skulls
- Militarily, Nobunaga changed the way war was fought in Japan
 - Developed, implemented, and expanded the use of long pikes, firearms and castle fo rtifications in accordance with the expanded mass battles of the period
- Nobunaga is remembered in Japan as one of the most brutal figures of the Sengoku period and was recognized as one of Japan's greatest rulers

Akechi Mitsuhide

- First called "Jubei" & later "Koretō Hyūga no Kami"
- Famous for betraying & forcing Oda Nobunaga to commit seppuku at the Incident of Honno-ji
- Rumored to be a childhood friend or cousin of Nohime
- After successfully defending the shogun Yoshiaki Ashikaga, Oda asked Mitsuhide to join his troops
 - One of Oda's most trusted retainers
- Had a 13 day reign as shogun



- Tenkai
- He (Mitsuhide) was rumored to have been killed by a peasant warrior by the name of Nakamura with a bamboo spear
- However, there were also rumors that he was not killed, but rather started a new life as a priest called Tenkai.



TSURUHIME

- Based on Öhöri Tsuruhime
 - Daughter of head priest of Oyamazumi Shrine in Omishima (Iyo Province), Ōhōri Yasumochi
- Tsuruhime joined the battle with her brother and her lover
- She kept fighting until she heard about her beloved lover's death
 - She quickly committed suicide by drowning herself then & died at a young age (18 years old)

Yoshiaki Mogami

- Daimyō of the Yamagata domain in Dewa Province, in the late Sengoku period and early Edo period
- aka "The Noble Fox of Ushu/Dewa" and has a mixed reputation in fictional sources
 - He is sometimes depicted as a wise ruler or as a villainous man who didn't fight at all
- Date Masamune's uncle



MATSUNA GA HISA HIDE

- Brother is Ashikaga
 Yoshiaki
 - Villain in SB4
- His apparent destruction of the Buddhist Todaiji in Nara was considered an act of infamy
- Hisahide often appears as a shriveled and scheming old man in fiction
 - In truth, he was a tall, handsome, and educated man as well as a patron of arts

Kanbe Kuroda

- Aka "Kuroda Yoshitaka"
- Renowned as a man of great ambition, he was a chief strategist and an adviser to Toyotomi Hideyoshi
- Yoshitaka made an attempt to conquer the region of Kyūshū during the Battle of Sekigahara, but this ended up in failure



OTANI YO SHITSUGU

- Romanticized in poetry and fiction as Ishida Mitsunari's heroic and talented friend since the Edo Period
- Was rumored to actually be Ishida Mitusnari's lover
- Most of his life is a mystery
- Was forced to use a palanguin for transportation due to his leprosy

Honda Tadakatsu

- Honda Tadakatsu was one of the Tokugawa Four Heavenly Kings
- Toyotomi Hideyoshi noted that the best samurai were "Honda Tadakatsu in the east and Tachibana Muneshige in the west"
 - Even Takeda Shingen praised Honda, saying that "[h]e is a luxury of Tokugawa Ieyasu".
- Tadakatsu is often referred to as "The Warrior who surpassed Death itself"
 - Due to never suffering a significant wound, despite participating in over 60 battles by the end of his life




ISHIDA MITSUNARI

- Childhhood name was Sakichi
- Led the Western army in the Battle of Sekigahara following the Azuchi-Momoyama period of the 17th century
- Mitsunari became known as a talented financial manager due to his knowledge and skill at calculation
 - After Hideyoshi seized power
- Mitsunari was a leader of bureaucrats in Hideyoshi's government, and was known for his rigid character

Ieyasu Tokugawa

- Held the last Shugunate of Japan
 - The Tokugawa
 Shogunate would rule
 Japan for the next 250 years.
- He was both careful and bold—at the right times, and at the right places
- Calculating and subtle, Ieyasu switched alliances when he thought he would benefit from the change



 Some daimyos/samurai seemingly ridiculous outfits are based on the actual armor

Date, Tadakatsu, & Naoe for example







- 1st off, senryu
 - Japanese form of short poetry similar to haiku in construction
 - 3 lines with 17 or fewer total 'morae'/"on" (more or less translates to syllables)
 - Tend to be about human foibles while haiku tend to be about nature
 - Often cynical or darkly humorous while haiku are more serious





























